ORDINANCE NO. 2006- 1259

BEING AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CONSOLIDATED SERVICE PLAN FOR IRON MOUNTAIN METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NOS. 1-3, IN THE TOWN OF WINDSOR, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Town of Windsor, Colorado (the "Town") is a home rule municipality duly organized and existing under article XX of the Colorado Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Board (the "Board") have been duly elected, chosen and qualified; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 32-1-204.5 and 32-1-205, C.R.S., as amended, the Consolidated Service Plan for Iron Mountain Metropolitan District Nos. 1-3 has been submitted to the Board; and

WHEREAS, notice of the hearing before the Board was duly published in the *Windsor Beacon* on September 7, 2006; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Title 32, Article 1, C.R.S., as amended, the Board held a hearing on the Consolidated Service Plan for Iron Mountain Metropolitan District Nos. 1-3 on September 11, 2006, and September 25, 2006, in connection with the adoption on first and second reading of an Ordinance approving the Consolidated Service Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered the Service Plan, and all other testimony and evidence presented at the hearing; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR, COLORADO:

1. The hearings before the Board were extensive and complete; that all pertinent facts, matters and issues were submitted; that all interested parties were heard or had the opportunity to be heard; and, that evidence satisfactory to the Board of each of the following was presented:
 - a. There is sufficient existing and projected need for organized service in the area to be served by the proposed special districts.
 - b. Existing service in the area to be served by the proposed special districts is inadequate for present and projected needs.
 - c. The proposed special districts are capable of providing economical and sufficient service to the areas they intend to serve.

d. The areas to be included within the proposed special districts have or will have the financial ability to discharge the proposed indebtedness on a reasonable basis.

2. That the Town Board of the Town of Windsor, Colorado, does hereby determine that the requirements of sections 32-1-202(2) and 32-1-203(2), C.R.S., relating to the filing of a Consolidated Service Plan for Iron Mountain Metropolitan District Nos. 1-3, and the requirements of Section 32-1-204.5, C.R.S., relating to the approval of the Consolidated Service Plan, have been fulfilled in a timely manner.

3. That the Town Board of the Town of Windsor, Colorado, does hereby approve the Consolidated Service Plan for Iron Mountain Metropolitan District Nos. 1-3, as presented to the Board.

4. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed in the records of the Town and submitted to the petitioners for the purpose of filing in the District Court of Weld County.

5. That all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions hereof shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
